This option requires a minimum total of 52 semester credit hours.
 Non-Thesis Track: Non-Thesis students must complete and pass comprehensive examinations (0 credit) and complete the SLHS 7920 Internship (5 credits). This option requires a minimum total of 53 semester credit hours.

¹ Internship is required for non-thesis track students and is recommended for thesis track students.

² Thesis hours should be completed by second year spring, but may be distributed across previous semesters.
