## Journalism (JRNL) or Sports Production (JRSP)

Students must apply for admission to the JRNL /JRSP major.

Before applying, students must:

- Complete CMJN 2100 with a C or better.
- Complete the fundamentals class:
  - If the student applies Fall 2023 or later, the student must complete JRNL 1000 with a "C" or better.
  - If the student applies prior to Fall 2023, the student must complete JRNL 1AA0 or JRNL 1100 with a "C" or better.
- Complete JRNL 2210 with a "C" or better.
- Successfully complete 30 hours of degree-applicable course credits (including transfer, AP, and proficiency credits) and be a student in good standing at the time of the application.
- In a well written a 300-word essay, free of spelling and grammar errors, explaining how the Journalism program fits with your academic and professional goals.
- Students who transfer to Auburn University may apply to the JRNL major but must complete one semester at Auburn University before applying for admission.
